

I've Got A Mansion - E9th 1st Verse - Key Of C

A Raises 5 and 10 a full tone, B raises 3 and 6 a half tone, H raises 1 a full tone and 2 a half tone

E lowers 4 and 8 a half tone, F raises 4 and 8 a half tone

Tab in red is a great general purpose riff to learn and will work in any song to transition to a 7th chord

The red tab on row 4 shows a neat 3 string grip with the 4 and 8 strings in unison. This gives you a very fat sound! (Yee Haw!)

The red tab on row 6 shows use of the H knee lever, raising string 1 a full tone and 2 a half tone. This has the same effect as the A and B pedals on strings 5,6 and 8. Notice how clear and high a tone this creates!

The red tab on rows 7 and 9 use an augmented sound and can add some dramatics to your playing in a hurry!
