Tab 1263 - C6 tuning - D string on top
Using string 4 half tone raise for more than just a dominant 7<sup>th</sup> sound!
K raises string 4 a half tone
K works well with pedals 5,6 and 8 as well as by itself
You'll hear this change on a lot of Curly Chalker recordings
Use finger picks to pick top two strings and strum bottom 2 strings with thumb pick
If you add the root note to the pedal 8 and 4<sup>th</sup> string raise you get a nice b9th chord
